#### DANCE STYLES WE OFFER

JAZZ: A dynamic, modern style of dance that allows students to show off their individual flair & personality.

TAP: A rhythmical & technical dance style using tap shoes to create audible beats and sounds.

BALLET: Ballet is the foundation behind all dance styles and is highly recommended for students wanting to further improve posture, strength, flexibility & leg lines.

CONTEMPORARY / LYRICAL: Is an expressive dance style that combines elements of jazz and ballet together. it involves fluid movements that are often expressed in conjunction with particular music genres.

HIP HOP: Is an urban style of dance where students use energy and strength to create strong dances, often including fun tricks!

MUSICAL THEATRE: Is a more theatrical performance piece which can combine song, singing, dialogue, acting & dance!

ACRO DANCE: In this class, students learn how to correctly conduct safe acrobatic movements that are combined into a dance piece.

TECHNIQUE CLASS: This class focuses on strength, flexibility, stretching & recovery - all of which are important to help improve students dance abilities and necessary for all competitive dance students.

TINY TOTS / LIL GROOVERS: This class caters to our littlest dancers and aims to share our love of dance in a fun and caring environment. They will learn age appropriate basic ballet and jazz skills through fun movement, music & games!

TROUPE: Our Performance / Eisteddfod Troupe Teams are aimed at those who wish to compete and take their dance to the next level. These classes are held in addition to other weekly dance classes and the Technique Class. Each troupe aims to learn a Jazz, Contemporary/Lyrical & Hip Hop Routine to compete with.

Please note - our troupe teams are year-long commitments and most competitions are held in school holidays or on weekends. A separate note will be distributed in Term 1 to troupe students with competition dates for the year. This class requires commitment from every team member to perform at a high level. Every child will also require a personalised CC Studio Jacket to be worn to all competitions.

PRIVATE TUITION: We offer private lessons for Solos, Duos & Trios for those who wish to train in a more tailored approach. This may be to create / perform individual dance pieces or to focus on improving specific dance skills.



#### **UNIFORM**

Students are to wear all black dance attire / active wear. This may be a leotard, singlet, tights or shorts - anything they can freely move in. Tiny Tots & Lil Groovers can wear whatever their little hearts desire to help encourage their creativity freedom!

#### **DANCE SHOES**

Correct footwear is important for the protection of students feet and safety during dance.

Jazz & Musical Theatre: Tan slip-on Jazz Shoes

Tap: Tan Tap Shoes

Hip Hop: Black Sneakers

Contemporary: Half Sole Dance Shoe in Tan

Acro: No Shoes

Ballet: Pink Ballet Shoes

Hair must be neatly tied back and out of students faces. This may be a bun, pony tail or braids etc.

#### TERMLY INVOICING & PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Term invoices will be distributed at the beginning of each term and must be paid in full by Week 3. Late fees apply and students who have not paid by Week 3 will be asked to pause dance lessons until payment has been received.

Unfortunately we can no longer accept weekly or part payments unless a specific payment plan is organised with Miss Chelsea.

Payment can be made via direct deposit or with cash in a sealed and labelled envelope.

To help financially prepare families, we have noted all expenses below. Please keep in mind, we do our utmost best to keep all costs at our studio as affordable for you as possible.

Costumes are \$55 per dance (most classes do 2 dances) This covers the cost of the costume, customs import & duty taxes, shipping and the time to curate, source & sort each class costume in the correct sizing and quantity. Costume Fees are due Term 3.

There is a \$40 Concert Fee to help cover Rehearsal and Concert expenses which is due in Term 4.

This includes venue hire fees, lighting and music technicians, teaching staff and concert awards per child.

All other expenses are optional:

Costume photography (packages start at \$35)

Concert Videography (\$50)

Concert Tickets (\$30-\$45 pp)







# **DANCE STUDIO POLICIES**

## **PARENTS**

- Every student is required to fill out a new registration form each year, regardless of if they are new or returning. When parents sign this form, you are agreeing to adheare to the 2025 Fee Schedule and our Dance Studio Policies.
- We communicate via many ways; newsletters, emails, Facebook & Instagram posts & notes. Please follow us on social media and check your emails to ensure you're up to date as we are trying to go paper-free in 2025!
- Term Fees must be paid by Week 3 of each term. A late fee of \$10 / week will apply for every subsequent week after week 4 until term fees are paid. Students will not be permitted to attend dance classes until term fees are up to date.
- We do not tolerate any bullying in our studio. We pride ourselves on providing a happy, welcoming & safe environment for all our students. If your child experiences any form of bullying, please inform the teacher immediately so we can address the issue at hand promptly & appropriately.
- Photographs & Videography are occasionally taken during classes & performances. If you do not wish for your child's photograph to appear on our website or social media etc please ensure you state this on your registration form.
- Occasionally teachers will need to correct students during dance class (verbally & physically). Any physical contact to help alignment, stretch or movement will be conducted appropriately & respectfully.
- CC Choreography has insurances for Public & General Liability, Professional Indemnity & Management Liability. Our staff all hold current working with children checks too.

## **STUDENTS**

- Students should bring all their personal dance belongings in a bag including dance shoes, water bottle, snacks & clothing.
- Mobile phones must be kept inside dance bags and not to be used during class times.
- Students are required to wear all black dancewear and bring correct dance shoes to each lesson.
- Food and drinks are not to be shared. Please also be conscious of food allergies among students and pack snacks that are nut-free to eliminate any risks.
- We encourage students to arrive 5 minutes early to each class to prepare for class and start their own mini warm up. This will help teach commitment & dedication, along with minimising the risk of injury.
- Teachers must be informed of any preexisiting or new injuries prior to dance classes.
- Most importantly, we want all our students to have fun in our studio whilst learning and growing their passion for dance! Happy Dancing to all our wonderful students!!
